

BTOP FOOTBALL PROGRAMME 01

BTOP Football Programme was established in 2009, a haven for the youths to play, learn, and explore their potentials under the guidance of professional coaches.

We believe through the active participation of football, these kids will be able to not only learn the importance of sportsmanship and cooperation but also to keep them motivated and disciplined to bloom into wholesome young adults.

This programme is currently conducted in SMK Badak, Bachok.

BTOP ARCHERY PROGRAMME 02

BTOP Archery Programme was introduced to open up opportunities for underprivileged kids to participate in archery. Through this programme, participants gain access to archery equipment, training under the guidance of a professional coach, and compete in prestigious tournaments.

Currently, this programme is conducted in 2 schools (SK Mentuan and SMK Kubang Kerian). Participants consist of both boys and girls, aged 10 to 15 years old.

This year, our young athletes managed to score 1 silver and 5 bronze medals in the annual MSSD Bachok. They were qualified to compete in MSS Kelantan 2020.

BTOP FUTSAL PROGRAMME:

Heroes of Cruyff Court & Futsal In English

BTOP Futsal Programme has been a hit among the local community. Today, a total of 88 participants this year, consisting of 27 girls and 59 boys aged 8 to 14 years old.

For Heroes of Cruyff Court Programme, participants are divided into several categories (under 12, 10, and 8 boys; under 12 and 10 girls) according to their age and genders to promote fair play and improve their communication skills among peers. A total of 67 students are involved.

Another branch of the futsal programme includes Futsal in English (FIE) training, which utilises English as the medium of instruction and communication. 21 boys participated in this programme.

123 BOOST ME UP: Intervention Class (IVC)

Due to COVID-19 pandemic, our sports programmes were halted temporarily.

The programme "123 Boost Me Up" is part of our community-based programme under Yayasan Hasanah Special Grant to help aiding underprivileged students to catch up with their studies during the pandemic, whereby students are less motivated to study and have limited internet access to participate in online classes.

IVC is an intensive class for SPM, to improve the SMK Badak students' grades in History and Bahasa Melayu. Syarikat Muda Osman SDN BHD (SMO) has contributed 70 free reference books worth RM1765.00 for the students in support of the initiative

Upon entering the RMCO period, a short course was conducted for BTOP coaches to update new coaching methods and full procedure of sanitation to ensure compliance with the new SOPs introduced.

During the course, coaches were given simulated situations and required to perform instructions as demonstrated beforehand.

Since the announcement of the opening of schools in July after the first MCO, BTOP Academy wasted no time in aiding our beneficiaries by providing face masks for the students, to ensure the safety of the students.

The masks were handed out on 26th July and 28th July for SK Mentuan and SMK Badak respectively. Each school received 300 masks.

We have chosen reusable masks to increase the probability of students to stick with the new SOP and regulation, enabling a more sustainable and cost-effective method to combat the pandemic.

As for YouTube (B-TOP TV), we have increased the media and production quantity and quality to help reducing stress and to deliver informative and entertaining videos.


